



NovaQuant Quick Start Guide

This guide shows users how to install the Windows .exe, launch the app, and get comfortable with the workflow quickly.

Best starting point: open NovaQuant, learn the main chart first, then add overlays and settings gradually.

What NovaQuant is

NovaQuant is a desktop crypto charting and signal utility built around a chart-first workflow. It combines market monitoring, useful overlays, signal visibility, optional alerts, and paper trading inside one focused desktop environment.

Before you install

- A Windows PC
- The NovaQuant .exe file
- Internet access for normal market data use
- Permission to run desktop apps on your computer

How to install the EXE

Option 1 - Run the EXE directly	Option 2 - Create a shortcut
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Download the NovaQuant .exe file.2. Move it to a folder you want to keep it in.3. Double-click the .exe to launch NovaQuant.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Right-click the NovaQuant .exe.2. Select Create shortcut.3. Move the shortcut to your desktop.

If Windows shows a security prompt

On some systems, Windows may show a warning before opening a new .exe. If that happens, click **More info** and then **Run anyway**. Only do this if the file came from a trusted source.



First launch

- Let the app finish loading.
- Review the chart layout and watchlist.
- Open the settings area only if you want to adjust preferences right away.
- Start by learning the chart before changing too many options at once.

Recommended first steps

1. Learn the main chart	Get comfortable with the chart view first.
2. Set your watchlist	Focus on the markets you actually want to follow.
3. Turn on only the overlays you want	Keep the chart readable and add structure gradually.
4. Review signal behavior	Make sure the signal flow makes sense before making major changes.
5. Use paper trading	Paper trading is the safest way to learn the workflow before relying on it more heavily.

Basic tips

- Start simple.
- Change one setting at a time.
- Keep the chart readable.
- Use paper trading early.
- Let the workflow feel familiar before customizing too much.



Troubleshooting

The EXE will not open	Make sure the file finished downloading. Try moving it out of Downloads and into a normal folder like Desktop or Documents. Right-click the file and choose Run as administrator if needed.
Windows blocks the app	Use More info > Run anyway only if you trust the file source.
The app opens but looks wrong	Close it and reopen it. Make sure your display scaling is set normally in Windows. Try launching it from a local folder instead of cloud storage or a zip preview.
The EXE is still inside a zip	Extract the zip first, then launch the .exe from the extracted folder.

Updating NovaQuant

When you receive a newer version, close the old version, replace the old .exe with the new one, and then launch the new version. If you keep shortcuts, make sure they still point to the correct file.

Uninstalling

If NovaQuant was provided as a standalone .exe, uninstalling is usually simple: close the app, delete the .exe, and delete any shortcut you created. If you were given a full folder version, remove the folder after closing the app.

Support

If you run into issues, send a screenshot of the problem, the exact step where it happened, and any error message shown on screen. That makes troubleshooting much faster.

Start with the chart, keep the workflow simple, and build from there.
